## BCNA - Neurological Supporter

**If you or someone close to you has been affected by a neurological or neuromuscular condition, could you volunteer for the Black Country Neurological Alliance (BCNA)?**

### **Purpose of the role:**

To help the BCNA gather views and feedback from people in the Black Country who are affected (directly or indirectly) by a neurological or neuromuscular condition.

To support the BCNA's engagement with local health and social care organisations (including Clinical Commissioning Groups, hospital trusts, healthcare practitioners, community services and local charities)

### **General Requirements:**

- \* *Be committed to the purpose and values of the BCNA*
- \* *Able to attend local healthcare meetings and events*
- \* *Able to feedback information on local support services*
- \* *Encourage neurological / neuromuscular charities and associated support groups to work with the BCNA to improve health and social care services in the Black Country.*

### **Specific Tasks**

Where possible:

- \* Attend healthcare meetings and other events on behalf of BCNA as agreed
- \* Provide feedback to the BCNA committee about events attended
- \* Provide timely out of pocket expense submissions for any agreed BCNA activities
- \* Attend your local area BCNA neurological forum
- \* Attend the BCNA AGM.
